

**Safer Buildings  
Form 42 - Affected Private Building Notice**

**Building Act 1975 (QLD) (the Act) section 261 and Building Regulation 2006 (Qld) (the Regulation) section 16ZA.**

This notice must be

- displayed in a conspicuous position; and
- securely attached to a wall, or the internal side of a door, near a main entry point to the building; and
- if the building has a fire indicator panel – also securely attached to a wall, or the internal side of a door, that is adjacent to the panel.

This notice must be displayed within 60 business days after the building fire safety risk assessment is given to the owner; and until either –

- the combustible cladding is removed from the building; or
- a private certifier gives the owner a notice stating that the combustible cladding complies with the Building Code of Australia.

<p><b>1. Affected Private Building Statement</b> The building fire safety risk assessment will state if the building is an affected private building.
